



LEARN TO SKATE COVID-19 MITIGATION PLAN

Welcome to the winter session of the ISI Learn to Skate program at Ben Boeke!

Our classes will be running at a lower capacity due to the COVID-19 restrictions. The classes we are offering are included on the registration form. Please note that we will not be able to accommodate brand new skaters for this session due to social distancing requirements. Skaters and **one adult** may enter the building no more than 15 minutes before their schedule ice time and must exit no more than 15 minutes after their scheduled time. Please be sure to sign the contact tracing log upon entering the building. The adult parent/chaperone may assist their skater in donning their skates, but will need to exit the building after doing so. No spectators are allowed in the building (per municipal mandate). **Masks are required for all individuals entering and exiting the building – no exceptions.** Masks must be worn at all times even when on the ice. Gloves must be worn by all participants.

We will be entering and exiting the rink at two different doors that will be marked. Please be sure to practice social distancing while in the facility. Please maintain social distancing from anyone not in your household.
